Directions to the Mora Research Center

The Research Center is located on the West end of town between mile markers 30 and 31 on the south side State Highway 518, Mora's main road.

Directions from Las Vegas and Points South

If you are coming from South of Las Vegas and heading north on Interstate 25, the easiest (*least amount of Las Vegas traffic*) way is to go to Exit 347 and turn left at the bottom of the off ramp like you be heading back towards Las Vegas. Get in the right hand lane since you will be taking the very first right hand turn (Legion Drive). Proceed west on Legion Drive until you get to the stop light at 7th Street. You will go by a hospital, elementary school and a couple of stop signs. Turn right on 7th Street, which is also State Highway 518, and proceed north to the town of Mora.

Once you come into the Mora Valley you will drive through most of the town. The Center is located between mile markers 30 and 31 on the south (left) side of the road. As you go through Mora you will pass several businesses including a grocery store, an Allsup's convenience store, a Chevron Station. You will see a Pizza Pro sign on the right hand side of the road. The Center is located roughly 100 feet further on the opposite side of the road. We have a small sign near the road and a larger sign a little further back. Drive through the red gate and in about 150 years you will have arrived at the Center.

Directions from Angel Fire and Points North.

Take State Highway 434 south towards Black Lake and Mora. When you get to Mora, State Highway 434 ends at the intersection with State Highway 518. Turn right onto State Highway 518 and follow the directions from above.

Directions from Wagon Mound and points East

Take State highway 120 towards the towns of Ocate, Ojo Feliz and La Cueva. State highway ends at the intersection with State Highway 518. Turn right onto State Highway 518 and follow the directions from above.

Directions from Taos and Points North and West

Take State Highway 518 towards Mora. Once you get into the Mora Valley, the Center is located between mile markers 31 and 30 on the south (right) side of the road. The neighbor's tree blocks much of our sign so the best way to see where the Center's red gate entrance is, is by looking for the Pizza Pro sign on the left hand side of the road. The entrance to the Center is about 100' closer than the Pizza Pro sign on the opposite (left side) of the road. If you miss the entrance, there are several businesses further down the road where you can turn around safely.
